MEMORANDUM FOR: Kingsville Navy League, Hahn Scholarship Committee

SUBJECT: Hahn Scholarship Proposal

1. This is a draft proposal from the Texas A&M University-Kingsville Army ROTC Battalion to the Kingsville Navy League for the disposition of the Hahn Scholarship. We extend our thanks for being considered for custodianship of the Hahn Scholarship and we look forward to expanding our relationship with the Kingsville Navy League.
2. We propose that the Hahn Scholarship be Called the Hahn Leadership Excellence Scholarship. We would like to award the scholarship to the student who demonstrates leadership excellence in school and/or in the community. The student should have accomplishments in both academics and physical fitness and show demonstrated leadership or potential. The scholarship and applicants should meet the following criteria:
  - a. Scholarship Details.
    - 1) Scholarship Award: \$1,000 a year, in two \$500 increments at the beginning of each semester.
    - 2) Number of Scholarships: One (1).
    - 3) Awarded at the beginning of the fall semester of the school year.
  - b. Applicant Criteria.
    - 1) Graduated from local area high schools. The Professor of Military Science (PMS) may waiver this requirement if there are no applicants from these schools.

- 2) Enroll or be enrolled full-time at Texas A&M University-Kingsville and in at least one, three-hour Army ROTC class. The PMS may waive this requirement for those applicants who have prior military service.
  - 3) Maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA.
  - 4) Maintain a minimum Army Physical Fitness Test score of 210 or more, scoring at least 70 points in each event, (push-ups, sit-ups, 2-mile run). PMS may waive.
  - 5) Students may be Freshmen, Sophomores, Juniors, Seniors or Graduate Students.
  - 6) Students must have a clean record and be in good standing with the university.
  - 7) Students with less than 30 college credit hours must have a minimum combined score of 920 on the SAT or a composite score of 19 on the ACT. PMS may waive if student is ranked in the top 10% of their high school graduating class.
  - 8) Be able to demonstrate leadership ability or potential.
  - 9) Apply before June 1.
3. The Professor of Military Science will:
- a. Establish an account with the university called Hahn Scholarship Account.
  - b. Review the application packets and select the winner based upon the criteria in paragraph 2b.
  - c. Coordinate with Kingsville Navy League to present the award during the summer or at the beginning of the school year.
  - d. Ensure quality control of application packets.
  - e. Prepare all administrative documents to transfer funds from scholarship account to the account of the scholarship winner at the beginning of each semester.
  - f. Promote the scholarship at local high schools, colleges and on campus.
4. The Kingsville Navy League will:
- a. Provide funds for the scholarship to the university in the name of the scholarship fund.
  - b. Present the scholarship to the recipient, as you see fit.
  - c. Establish additional criteria as you see fit.
  - d. Promote the scholarship through its members and member businesses.
